1. Entries will be limited to 144 Competitors. In the event of more than 144 entries being received, the Committee reserve the right to reduce the number to the stated limit by eliminating a sufficient number having the higher handicaps, and thereafter by ballot. In the event of insufficient entries being received, the Committee reserve the right to accept late entries.
2. Competitors will be made temporary Honorary Members of the Club on the day of the Competition.
3. Any competitor whose handicap has been altered at any Club between the date of entry and the competition shall advise the Secretary/General Manager under penalty of disqualification.
4. The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason for their action, and all disputes shall be referred to it for its decision which shall be final.
5. Refunds will not be made to any competitor who withdraws within 7 days of the competition.
6. In the event of a tie (or ties), the rules of the Lancashire Union of Golf Clubs shall apply.
7. The attention of all competitors is drawn to Rule of Golf 6-7, dealing with undue delay.
8. The use of a distance measuring device is permitted for this competition.
9. No competitor may win more than 1 prize. In any category of prize the Gross Prize will be awarded and then the Nett Prize etc. All prize winners must hold an active handicap.
10. Smart casual dress is acceptable throughout the day in the Men's Lounge, Mixed Bar and Dining Room. Jacket and Tie must be worn after 8.00pm in the Dining Room.
